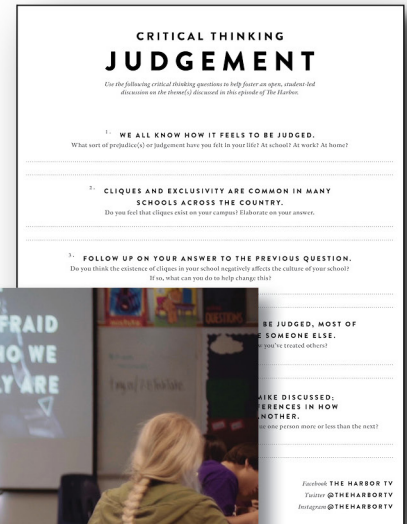
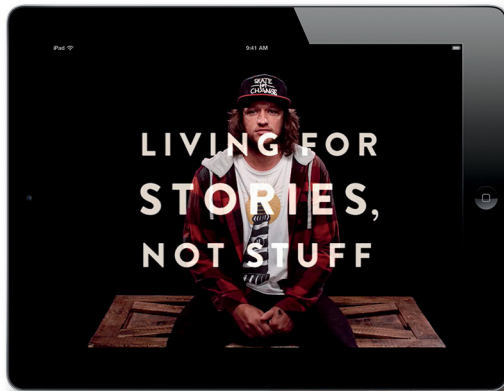


RENAISSANCE SOLUTIONS
