OVERVIEW

Challenge a few "celebrity" contestants to a round of "Are You Smarter than a 5th Grader" for little or no cost while charging admission at the door (one school charged \$1 for tickets).

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.Borrow or purchase "Are You Smarter than a 5th Grader" board game.
- 2. Select a date, time, and location to hold your event.
- 3. Promote the event to parents, staff, students and community through social media, local media, flyers and posters.
- 4. Invite staff or parents to donate refreshments to sell. (Optional)
- 5. Recruit a volunteer to be the game show host.
- 6. Recruit a couple of 5th graders to be the contestants' "classmate."
- 7. Recruit some "celebrity" contestants, such as a principal, vice principal, and a couple of teachers.
- 8. Hold a rehearsal session with all of the contestants and the game show host so that everyone will know what's expected during the event.
- 9. Recruit a trusted volunteer to take admission fees at the door. You can set the admission fee to whatever you think is appropriate. Some schools charge as little \$1 per person.
- 10. Welcome guests, and let the games begin!
