INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Pick a date, time, and location for your race.
- 2. Ask local businesses to serve as race sponsors in exchange for their business logo to be placed on your race t-shirts.
- 3. Determine a starting and ending point for your race.
- 4. Advertise and promote your race. Allow for participants to register in person, online through your school's website, and online through popular running websites.
- 5. Design and order t-shirts for race participants.
- 6. Purchase powder paint and corn starch (mix 1:1) for your color stations.
- 7. Purchase 5-gallon buckets to hold your paint mixture on the day of the race.
- 8. Design and order medallions for your race participants.
- 9. Purchase drinks and fruit for race participants.
- 10. Have fun!!!

ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

- -Invite colleges and the military to set up booths at the event. Ask the military recruiters if they can bring a military vehicle to display or a rock climbing wall!
- -Include a "fun run" for children that is shorter in distance so they can participate as well
- -Laundry detergent caps work perfect as scoops for throwing the paint at the color stations
- -Have music playing before, during, and after the race-make it fun!!!
- -Emphasize that is a fun run-that way you can save on costs such as renting an official clock, numbered bibs, etc.
