INSTRUCTIONS

1. Design and order a “Decision Day” banner.
2. Order enough donuts for your senior class. If possible, order donuts with sprinkles that represent your school’s colors!
3. Promote and advertise “Decision Day” to your school community.
4. Set up a table with the banner and markers in a highly visible area for your seniors to sign their name and their postsecondary plans.
5. After they sign, they receive a donut!
6. Display the banner somewhere in your school.
7. Display the banner at your school’s graduation ceremony!
