## ROOM SERVICE CARDS



**School type:**  
High school, middle school

**Activity goal:**  
Showing appreciation to staffulty

**Prep time:**  
90 - 120 minutes

**People required:**  
1- 2 adults and 2 - 4 students

Large room for rolling cart

During school year

### OVERVIEW

Staffulty members complete a Room Service Card, then students knock on doors and deliver treats in room service style to them.

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Design Room Service Cards with spaces for name and room number, several beverage and treat choices, and check boxes.
2. Print, hole-punch cards, and place rubber bands on door knobs on Monday. Pick them up Wednesday afternoon.
2. Tally the items needed.
3. Purchase items.
4. Prepare beverages.
5. Divide up cards by hallways.
6. Deliver room service during designated class period/block.
7. Clean up and place leftover items in the teachers' workroom.

### ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Have a decorated Room Service cart and make it a privilege for students to be involved in making deliveries.
