OVERVIEW

To provide a reward/incentive for seniors to work toward a goal (ex. higher GPA), while also allowing seniors to leave a mark on the school by painting ceiling tiles.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Set a goal for students to achieve
- 2. Find the number of students who achieved that goal
- 3. Cut paper to fit on ceiling tile
- 4. Set time for students to paint on paper
- 5. Have time to dry painted paper
- 6. Clean up the stations and any messes made
- 7. When the paint is dry, begin taking tiles down and staple, tape or glue paper onto tiles
- 8. Place tiles back into ceiling

ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Take pictures of the tiles and include them as a yearbook spread. Encourage students to share photos of their tiles on social media.
