OVERVIEW

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Gather a group of students to organize and sell care packages
- 2. Pick & purchase items to go inside pencils, tissues, chocolates, mints, energy bars, inspirational messages, etc.
- 3. Stuff care packages
- 4. Reserve a table in the lunch room a few days before testing
- 5. Decide how much to charge for each bag enough to cover costs and generate a profit, especially if using this as a fundraiser!
- 6. Get a cash box with change
- 7. Sell them! Make posters or invite students to purchase them
- 8. Have students help sort the bags by homeroom and deliver the next day
