OVERVIEW

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Identify top 10 students with highest GPA through counselors.
2. Hold a school-wide assembly.
3. Have MC's welcome everyone and explain why all are gathered.
4. Start announcing the Top 10 seniors according to GPA. Students do not know where they fall until this moment. Staffulty are on stage and deliver the MC's an envelope containing the names.
5. As each student is announced, they will make their way from the audience and down the red carpet, having the paparazzi take their picture, and onto the stage. Once on the stage, they are presented with a certificate and the award.
